## But what does that have to do with the church world?

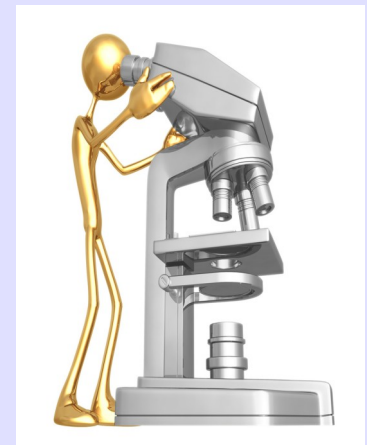
